## **Appeals Procedure**

## **General Appeals Procedure**

The Irish Suffolk Sheep Society adapts the following Appeals procedure for all its members:

Any breeder of the Irish Suffolk Sheep Society who has a grievance with the Society or with a fellow breeder must have an opportunity to have his/her grievance examined and resolved.

The appeals procedure is as follows:

1. The breeder must notify the Chairman or Secretary in writing of their grievance.
2. If the matter cannot be resolved by one or both officers within a ten day period it must be brought before the full committee within thirty days.
3. The breeder will be allowed to make an oral submission to the committee at this meeting.
4. The committee decision must be notified to the appellant within ten days.
5. If the matter cannot be resolved by the committee the breeder is entitled to a hearing by a neutral party agreeable to BOTH sides. If the matter goes to an independent hearing a ruling will have to be forth coming and BOTH sides must agree to accept this ruling BEFORE the hearing takes place.
